

Child care is expensive. We can help!

There is community support to help pay your child care costs. This support is available to low income working families and families that have left family assistance less than one year ago.

What you Get:

Providers are reimbursed for up to the market rate* of child care minus the family share of child care costs.

What you Pay:

The family share typically ranges from \$1 to 10% of the family total income, regardless of the number of children in care.
