#### A City of Refugees




- Mohawk Valley Resource Center for Refugees opened in 1979
- Over 13,000 refugees
- 31 different countries
- 17.6 % of Utica's population is foreign born

#### Fiscal History

- 1996 Sold water assets
- 2000s Used Water Trust Fund and reserve funds to balance budget
- 2012 NYS Comptroller threatened control board
- 2012 Overrode tax cap and balanced budget

#### Municipal Approach – Seeking Other Revenue Sources






